



40	25(Salt; sulphur; earths and stone; plastering materials, lime and cement)	<p>All goods not specified elsewhere</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. 2501 Salt other than common salt.</li><li>2. 2502 Unroasted iron pyrites.</li><li>3. 2503 Sulphur of all kinds, other than sublimed sulphur, precipitated sulphur and colloidal sulphur.</li><li>4. 2504 Natural graphite.</li><li>5. 2505 Natural sands of all kinds, whether or not coloured, other than metal bearing sands of Chapter 26.</li><li>6. 2506 Quartz (other than natural sands); quartzite, whether or not roughly trimmed or merely cut, by sawing or otherwise, into blocks or slabs of a rectangular (including square) shape.</li><li>7. 2507 Kaolin and other kaolinic clays, whether or not calcined.</li><li>8. 2508 Other clays (not including expanded clays of heading 6806), andalusite, kyanite and sillimanite, whether or not calcined; mullite; chamotte or dinas earths.</li><li>9. 2509 Chalk.</li><li>10. 2510 Natural calcium phosphates, natural aluminium calcium phosphates and phosphatic chalk.</li><li>11. 2511 Natural barium sulphate(barytes); natural barium carbonate (witherite), whether or not calcined, other than barium oxide of heading 2816.</li><li>12. 2512 Siliceous fossil meals (for example, kieselguhr, tripolite and diatomite) and similar siliceous earths, whether or not calcined, of an apparent specific gravity of 1 or less.</li><li>13. 2513 Pumice stone; emery; natural corundum, natural garnet and other natural abrasives, whether or not heat- treated.</li><li>14. 2514 Slate, whether or not roughly trimmed or merely cut, by sawing or otherwise, into blocks or slabs of a rectangular (including square) shape.</li><li>15. 2515 Ecaussine and other calcareous monumental or building stone; alabaster [other than marble Marble and travertine]</li><li>16. 2516 Porphyry, basalt, sandstone and other monumental or building stone, whether or not roughly trimmed or merely cut, by sawing or otherwise, into blocks or slabs of a rectangular (including square) shape.</li><li>17. 2517 Pebbles, gravel, broken or crushed stone, of a kind commonly used for concrete aggregates, for road metalling or for railway or other ballast, shingle and flint, whether or not heat-treated; macadam of slag, dross or similar industrial waste, whether or not incorporating the materials cited in the first part of the heading; tarred macadam; grenules cheeping and powder of stones heading 2515 or 2516</li></ol>
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
